\*\*Citizen Issues and Concerns: Re: Dogs Peter will take a copy of our ordinance to the ADA to look over and Gilly was in and registered all three dogs and will be in next week to pay the \$75.00 late fee. A motion was made by Steve to send Ted Reynolds a certified letter notifying him of the Boards decision regarding his training facility and barking dogs, seconded by Ron, all in favor.

Correspondence: Ron read several correspondences. We received URIP Notice and we will be getting \$26, 192.00, also from the Maine Preservation Commission stating that Keen Hall was entered in the National Register of Historic Places.

Fire Chief: It was reported that there is a lot of poison ivy in the ditch by the fire house and the playground.

Water base paint goes into the trash and oil or lead base must go to a collection place. Cindy will print out the information .and include it in the special town report.
