

August 28, 2017 Approved Minutes Selectmen's Meeting **Motions

Call to Order: Ron called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m. Those in attendance were, Selectman Steve Bennett, Selectman Brian Jones, Town Clerk Cindy Abbott, Fire Chief Jim Waterman, Treasurer Erna Keller, Secretary Sallyann Hadyniak and Bob Kanzler.

****Minutes:** Ron made a motion to approve the minutes of August 14th and to be placed on file, Steve seconded the motion, all in favor.

****Treasurer's Report:** Steve made a motion to accept the Payroll Warrant in the amount of \$5,957.37 and the A/P Warrant in the amount of \$4,381.43 seconded by Brian Jones. The ending check book balance is \$223,415.56.

Part of the receipts from the Rec. Comm. went toward purchasing 4 back packs with supplies for a family in need.

(\$25.64) Bob Kanzler donated an additional \$20.00.

Citizens Issues: There was a lengthy discussion regarding the Cellar Kitchen Road. The people, trash, and the smell of dope, lots of traffic, cars from out of state, etc. Ron made a motion that Steve go and call the Sheriff's Department, (Jeff Trafton) to see if there is anything illegal going on down there. Brian seconded the motion, all in favor.

ACO: Peter Nerber reported that he visited Gilley dogs and they have shock collars on and the box is 90 feet away. Gilley will make arrangements with Cindy to pay the fine of \$75.00.

Correspondence: Brian gave a copy of the state valuation to Steve and Ron.
