**Call to Order: 6:15**

**Public Works:** Travis gave a report regarding the sand, going slowly, rain is holding up the work. Dozer is delivered tonight and is being rented for a week for \$1,300.00. They were trying to come up with a solution. Dozer rented by the day is, \$430.00. The barriers were removed and placed in Wilson Hess's door yard. There is one charge account at Freedom General and Hill Top to be used for fuel only. Ron will put the teeter totter seat back on and will tighten the others. Also the train needs to be removed for it isn't safe.
