

approved Minutes March 19, 2018 Selectmen's Meeting **Motions

Call to Order: 6:05

****Review of Minutes:** Steve made a motion to approve the minutes of March 12th as written and to be placed on file. Ron seconded the motion. All in favor,

****Treasurer's Report:** Brian made a motion to accept the Payroll Warrant in the amount of \$5,296.40 and the A/P Warrant in the amount of \$7,823.46. Seconded by Steve. All in favor.

The ending checkbook balance is \$112,361.68.

Citizen Issues and Questions: Laura Greeley had questions and discussed the roads and Skidgels.

Meredith Coffin questioned the article 3 on the warrant regarding the LD1.

****Brian** made a motion to sign the contract regarding the cost recovery program and that we retain a copy for our files and the signed document to the service provider. We are the client, and to direct the Fire Chief to implement this program and to revisit this 30 days before the one year expiration which is in February 2019. No one is exempt.

****Steve** made a motion that the Chair of the Board (Ron) sign the document on behalf of the town. Brian seconded the motion, all in favor.

****Brian** made a motion to let the records show that Ron is the chair of the board and Steve seconded it. All in favor.

Fire Chief: Gave a report regarding bad equipment, He stated in another town, the Board of Selectmen ordered a department to stand down due to this issue. All equipment must be in excellent condition.

of****Ron** made a motion to pick up the units at a cost of \$2,800.00 for 2 units and 4 bottles of SCBA reconditioned and replacement is \$5,000.00. Brian seconded it and all were in favor.

Correspondence: Brian read a letter from Maine Municipal Bulletin regarding medical marijuana. Also Road Bills.

****Public Works:** The mirrors on Stevens Road and Pleasant Street are broken and need to be replaced at \$389.99 plus shipping. Brian made a motion to replace them Steve seconded it and all were in favor.

Steve gave a report about his meeting with Marcus Ballou MMA Risk Management Services on March 9, 2018 and gave a written report to the Board.

Roads: Brian brought up 0 Burnham Hill road and Ron said he is working on making a turnaround on the road.

Solid Waste: Meredith gave a report and would like to put out another compost report.

Health Related: Brian will set up an appointment with Susan Smith from Maine Municipal Health Trust and Public Works with one Selectman possibly on a Friday. All were in agreement.

Road Committee: Will meet on Wednesday, April 4th, starting at 7:00 p.m.

Planning Board: There was a brief discussion regarding the land and retail use of marijuana.

Cemetery Committee: Cindy need to or flags and holders for the cemetery including Pleasant Hill.

****Budget Committee:** Ron made a motion to have a budget committee meeting on Tuesday, May 22 at the Town Office starting at 6:00 p.m. Brian seconded it, all in favor.

Ron stated that the Board will make their committee appointments next week.

Fire Chief: Safety Works will be visiting the Freedom Fire Department and will be checking everything to make sure it is all in order, including the paper work.

****Steve** made a motion for Ron to sign the paper from the Norridgewock Land Fill saying that we know what we are doing when we go there. Brian seconded the motion and all were in favor.

The new Adopted Land Evaluation Schedule needs to be posted on the office wall.

Steve spoke to Jackie regarding Rick Martins abatement for three years.

Ron met with Fred from FEMA and went through the windstorm damages back in April. Ron will get information together for him and has 60 days to get all that information together and it looks like we can get back as much as \$4,000.00.

Ron suggested that we put up signs and ribbons, no trespassing, danger, etc.

****Ron** made a motion regarding Skidgels (now the town's property). The snowmobile's needs to be notified. Brian will call Buck about Hills to Sea. The trail is 47 miles long and there isn't any camp[ing] or facilities along the wayl.. All were in favor,

Steve called for an Executive Session for a legal Consultation 1 MRSA 405 (6) E at 8:03. They came out at 8:25. No decision was made.

Ron adjourned the meeting at 8:04 p.m. all in favor. The next meeting is Monday, March 26, 2018
